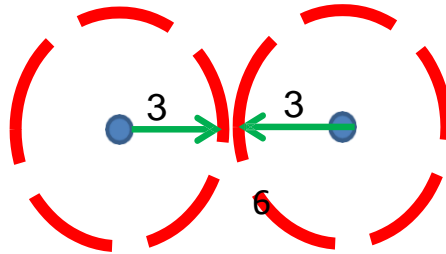


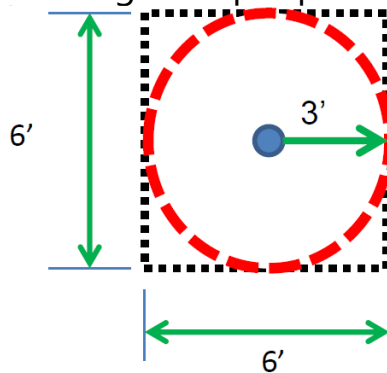


# Social Distancing Measures

1. CDC Guidelines: 6 feet of separation between any two persons.



2. Estimate Social Distancing Area per person as  $6' \times 6' = 36$  square feet.



3. Calculate surface area of the room. Example: 720 square feet.
4. Divide by 36 to find room capacity/number of persons. Example: 20 people.
5. In spaces where students congregate (classrooms, common spaces, cafeterias, etc.) subtract approximately 25% and round down. Example: 15 people.
